Layoff Warning Signs Checklist



Use this list to identify potential warning signs of organizational changes. While a few checked items don't guarantee layoffs are coming, multiple signs across different categories suggest it's time to prepare. Review periodically and use it to make informed decisions about your career.

Financial Signs:		
Corporate earnings are flat or declining

	Your performance review was unexpectedly negative		
	Manager requests more detailed reports than usual		
	You're asked to document all processes and procedures		
	Your boss is showing unusual interest in your daily tasks		
	Communication from leadership has decreased		
	Team morale has noticeably declined		
	You're experiencing unusual social distance from management		
	Previously engaged teams seem disengaged		
	Your department is behind on deadlines		
Project Status:			
	Projects are being cancelled or postponed		
	Time tracking is more strictly enforced		
	Unexpected performance reviews are happening		
	Teams must justify their headcount		
	Work is being redistributed		
	Project priorities keep shifting unexpectedly		
	Workload has significantly changed		
	New projects face unusual delays in starting

	IT is conducting unusual system audits	
	Security protocols are being modified	
	HR requests updated contact information	
	Unplanned company-wide meetings are scheduled	
	Remote work policies are changing	
	Expense policies are being tightened	
	Severance policies are being reviewed	
Industry & Market Signs:		
	Similar companies are conducting layoffs	
	Industry consolidation is happening (mergers & acquisitions)	
	Your company is losing market share	
	Negative media coverage is increasing	
	Marketing spending has decreased	
	Office space is being reduced	
	Suppliers can't reach finance department	
	Invoices are frequently "lost" or delayed	
	Supplier payments are consistently late
