- Our design-to-template workflow is translating Photoshop-created graphic design mock-ups into PHP or XSLT templates. Our QA process specifies rigorous cross-browser layout consistency (IE 6+, FF 3.5+, Google Chrome and Apple Safari, extended or amended on a project-level basis)
- Incorporates CSS2.1 and 3 and jQuery User Interface elements (and non-supported browser degradation) as required by design and function. Our QA insures cross-browser consistency and feature degradation as warranted.
- Converted an English-only, statically compiled site to an 8-language CMS-based site. The site has now been redesigned to a simplified English-only site following the customer's style guide and using Drupal
- Familiar with MVC frameworks, particularly Ruby on Rails and .NET MVC
- Providing graphic design services for print output.
- Assists clients with I.T. requests, largely related to web site project support.
- Consults and contracts Information Technology-related coverage for small businesses, such as Knowledge Process Company, from 2001 to 2005
- We use a rigorous QA methodology to ensure W3C-standards compliance.
